This 10-week internship will give you real-world experience working side-by-side with experienced professionals in commercial real estate. Interns will perform a variety of integral functions to support the operational functions of retail properties through working with the Property Management department. The internship will include shadowing business teams (Due Diligence, Finance, Acquisitions) to give full visibility to the lifecycle of a deal. At the conclusion of the internship, you will share a presentation to represent your work from the summer. The goal of this internship is to be in a position for the candidate to receive a full-time offer. The internship is 40 hours per week and will run from June to mid-August 2026.

- Become familiar with standard retail real estate terminology, including tutelage for reading governing documents
- Be introduced to property title, survey, zoning, and environmental reporting
- Visit locally owned properties to perform site inspections
- Interact with retailers to troubleshoot and log work order requests
- Coordinate with vendors (and vet as required) to process work orders
- Assist with onboarding newly acquired properties
- Competitively bid, qualify, and award contracts
- Meet and interact with each functional department
- Conduct store performance calls
- Assist in miscellaneous projects as assigned
- Create and share a presentation at the conclusion of the internship to showcase your work throughout the summer.
